AFS encourages Returnees to become Volunteers! As a Returnee Volunteer, you can continue your growth and development by building on the experiences and skills you gained during your AFS program.

Explore the volunteer roles below, designed specifically for Returnees, to continue the AFS mission of spreading intercultural awareness, this time among your family, friends and community. You can take part in multiple roles and volunteer locally with AFS, all depending on your interests and time.

Returnee Ambassador

AFS Returnee Ambassadors serve as educators in their communities, sharing their cultural experiences at schools, community events and cultural centers. Ambassadors will receive training on how to create and market their AFS story while gaining the leadership skills to organize and host events.

Returnee Mentor

AFS Returnee Mentors play a vital role in preparing AFSers to go abroad. Mentors are matched with 4-6 students who are interested in going abroad with AFS or preparing to depart for their AFS program. Mentors share their experiences and build relationships with their assigned students to help ease the anxiety of going abroad.

Returnee Country Specialist

AFS Returnee Country Specialists represent their study abroad country and provide future AFSers with the first-hand perspective of the expectations of living abroad by being a representative on AFS Online Info Sessions, country specific calls, the Ask an AFSer Facebook Page or as a referral.

Returnee Coordinator

The Area Team Returnee Coordinator is responsible for coordinating the support, recruitment, integration, orientation, and recognition of Returnees for the Area Team.
